### Module Access:

Students will receive access to all four modules within each Group at once. For example, Group A access (including modules 1 through 4) will begin on January 10 and continue through February 6, 2022, then on February 7 access will begin for all four modules within Group B. Students may progress through the modules within the active Group at their own pace but we recommend completing no less than one module per week.

### Program Grading and Completion:

Students must receive a score of 70% or better on the final exam and complete a Post-Course Survey for each module to receive credit for that module. Students must successfully complete 12 of the 16 modules to receive a Certificate for this Program.

Once your successful completion of the module exams and Post-Course Surveys has been confirmed by the CITE Program Coordinator, you will be sent a letter / transcript and a Completion Certificate indicating your total Continuing Education Units (CEUs).
